- Both the Gregorian and the Luni-solar calendation data were acquired from the National Aeronautics and Space Administration (N.A.S.A.), and according to them, they are accurate to a second.
- The Gregorian calendar data is displayed in black print, all other is Luni-solar calendar data.
- Overt differences become apparent as the Roman Gregorian calendar is compared to Yahuwah's Luni-solar calendar standard of Scripture.
- According to Scripture, the lunar phases determine the length of each month. The phases illustrated above will vary by one phase for a 29 or a 30 day month, which is not displayed.
- Exodus 12 & 16 defines that the year, month, week, and Sabbath, as well as all the yearly Sacred Festivals are to begin on specific fixed dates counting from the New Moon as day one.
- "The New Moon is still, and the Sabbath originally was, dependent upon the lunar cycle." *Univ. Jewish Ency.*

A halo of light and glory clustered about the time of Jesus' death and resurrection, immortalizing the sacred facts that he was the Saviour of the world. *Early Writings, p. 197*

Blow the trumpet at the time of the New Moon, at the full moon, on our solemn Feast day. For this is a statute for Israel, a law of the God of Jacob. *Psalms 81:3*

... the Saviour slowly made His way to ... Gethsemane. The Passover moon, broad and full, shone from a cloudless sky. *Desire of Ages, p. 685*

- "The Millerites were clear . . . that the first day of the new month always followed the moons first appearance, and did not precede it." *Grace Amadon 1939*
- There are twelve inseparable time centric criteria for Christ Yahshua's true Crucifixion date:
 1. Year - A.D. 31
 2. Season - Spring
 3. Month - Abib/Nissan
 4. 14th day from New Moon
 5. Day of Week - 6th day
 6. Preparation day - 6th day
 7. Full Moon day - 14th day
 8. On Passover day
 9. Crucifixion - 9th hour
 10. Festival of U.L. Bread - 15th
 11. High Sabbath in the Tomb
 12. Resur. Day/ Wave Sheaf - 16th
- Question: If seven-day cycles of successive weeks have never been broken since creation, then wouldn't all Saturday's be in perfect sync with Scripture's Lunisolar calendar Sabbaths above?
