Today is the **22nd** day of our Creator's **Sixth Lunar Month** count, in which the year begins in the spring. It is also the authentic **third lunar Sabbath of the month**. It looks like **06-22-5994**. It coincides with the Roman Gregorian calendar planetary date of *Mon., 09-29-2025*.

Our Creator placed His full moon beacon as the original New Moon and the start of His months, high above for all to see. All praise to Yahuah Alahim for His steadfast love and compassion for His children and His patience in restoring His lost truths in preparation for the Second Coming of His Son, Yahusha haMashiach (the Messiah). Simply because the full moon as New Moon, with its count to Lunar Sabbaths and annual Feast Days, is not popular among the Rabbinical Pharisee Jews or the

Romanized Christian churches today, does in no way diminish its LIGHT OF TRUTH shining from the pages of Scripture and His Eternal Throne. Only Yahuah's Ruach (power, presence, and provision) gives those who seek Him with all their hearts "*eyes to see and ears to hear.*" Ask Him today to reveal His New Moon and lunar Sabbath to you, and see how your life will change as your soul temple is synchronized to His for all eternity.

THE WAY TO THE MOUNTAINTOP

It was almost sundown. We were standing at the bottom of a high mountain. However, the ascent was very gradual, as the mountain was spread out over a vast area and connected to other mountains, part of a larger chain. At its base were the beginnings of several mountain paths, each diverging from the others.

“At the top of this mountain,” said the teacher, “is a flat, white, circular stone. Find it. When you get there, you’ll be standing on the summit. Find that stone and then return to me.”

“But which of the paths do I take?” I asked.

“That’s the challenge,” he said. “I’ll be waiting here until you return.”

So, I chose one of the many paths and began following it. It wasn’t long before the sky grew dark, and it became apparent that I was on the wrong path. I chose another, and another, until finally I realized I was heading downward. At that point, I began shouting in the dark for the teacher. He shouted back. Following his voice, I made my way back to him at the base of the mountain.

“So,” said the teacher, “I imagine you didn’t get there.”

“How could I have?” I replied. “I didn’t know which path to take.”

“You didn’t have to know,” he said. “You didn’t have to know anything except one thing. You were too focused on which path to take, but that wasn’t the key. Remember when I shared with you about the Hebrew word *Aliyah*.” Had you applied that here, you would have succeeded.

The key was the direction upward. The white stone was at the pinnacle. All you had to do was choose the higher path continuously. And if the path stopped ascending, then you choose the higher ground. And it would make no difference where you started from or on which side of the mountain. If you just followed this simple law, you would have reached the exact place at the pinnacle. Don’t forget this.

It’s one of the most important secrets in your walk with YAHUAH Alahim (God). The pinnacle of the mountain represents His calling on your life, His specific will and exact purpose and plan for your life. How do you get there? You don’t have to know where it is. All you have to do is continually ascend, continually choose the higher path, the higher ground, the higher footstep. And no matter where you started from and no matter where you are now, you will end up in the exact, specific, appointed, and perfect will of YAHUAH Alahim (God), at the summit, the pinnacle of His purposes for your life.”

The Mission: Today, focus only on one course, one path, one journey, one destination, and one direction – up. Aim to go higher with every step. Psalms 24:3-6; Proverbs 3:6; Philippians 3:14

Kerrie’s Korner:

Jonathan Cahn’s *“The Way to the Mountaintop”* paints such a vivid picture of our walk with Yahuah Alahim and His Son, our Messiah. It reminds us that reaching His perfect will isn’t about having every path mapped out in advance, but about the direction of our hearts and the steps we take each day. The Hebrew word *Aliyah*, to ascend, beautifully captures this. As the psalmist asks, *“Who shall ascend into the hill of Yahuah? or Who shall stand in His holy place? He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart”* (Psalm 24:3–4). Our part is to choose the higher ground, marked by holiness, humility, and obedience to His Torah Law, one step at a time. Each choice for righteousness lifts us closer to His summit.

This same truth shines through Solomon’s words: *“In all your ways acknowledge Him, and He shall direct your paths”* (Proverbs 3:6). We don’t need to know every turn beforehand; we only need to keep committing our way to Him. Like Jonathan, the student in the story, we may grow anxious about which trail to take, but the Father’s will unfolds as we keep pressing upward. Paul captured this so well when he wrote, *“I press toward the mark for the prize of the high calling of Alahim in Yahusha haMashiach”* (Philippians 3:14). Our journey isn’t about rushing to the top, but about continually choosing ascent until we find ourselves standing in the very center of His purpose upon the white rock.

This also speaks to every soul, no matter what world religion or tradition they may have been born into. Yahusha, the true Shepherd, calls each one to rise higher, to leave behind what cannot lead upward, and to follow His voice toward the pinnacle of truth. It isn’t our background or heritage that decides the outcome; it’s our willingness to respond to His call. Those who listen and step forward in faith will be led to the summit, into His presence. But those who stay in the comfort of the status

quo, ignoring His still small voice, will never reach that pinnacle. The invitation is for all, yet only the willing answer the call and will ascend.

And so, we are encouraged to trust this divine principle of upward movement, always to choose what is purer, nobler, and closer to the heart of our Redeemer. No matter where we've begun, every faithful step upward draws us nearer to His will. In this, we find both freedom and direction: not paralyzed by fear of the "wrong path," but empowered to keep climbing, ever upward, toward the mountain of Yahuah where His purposes are revealed in fullness.

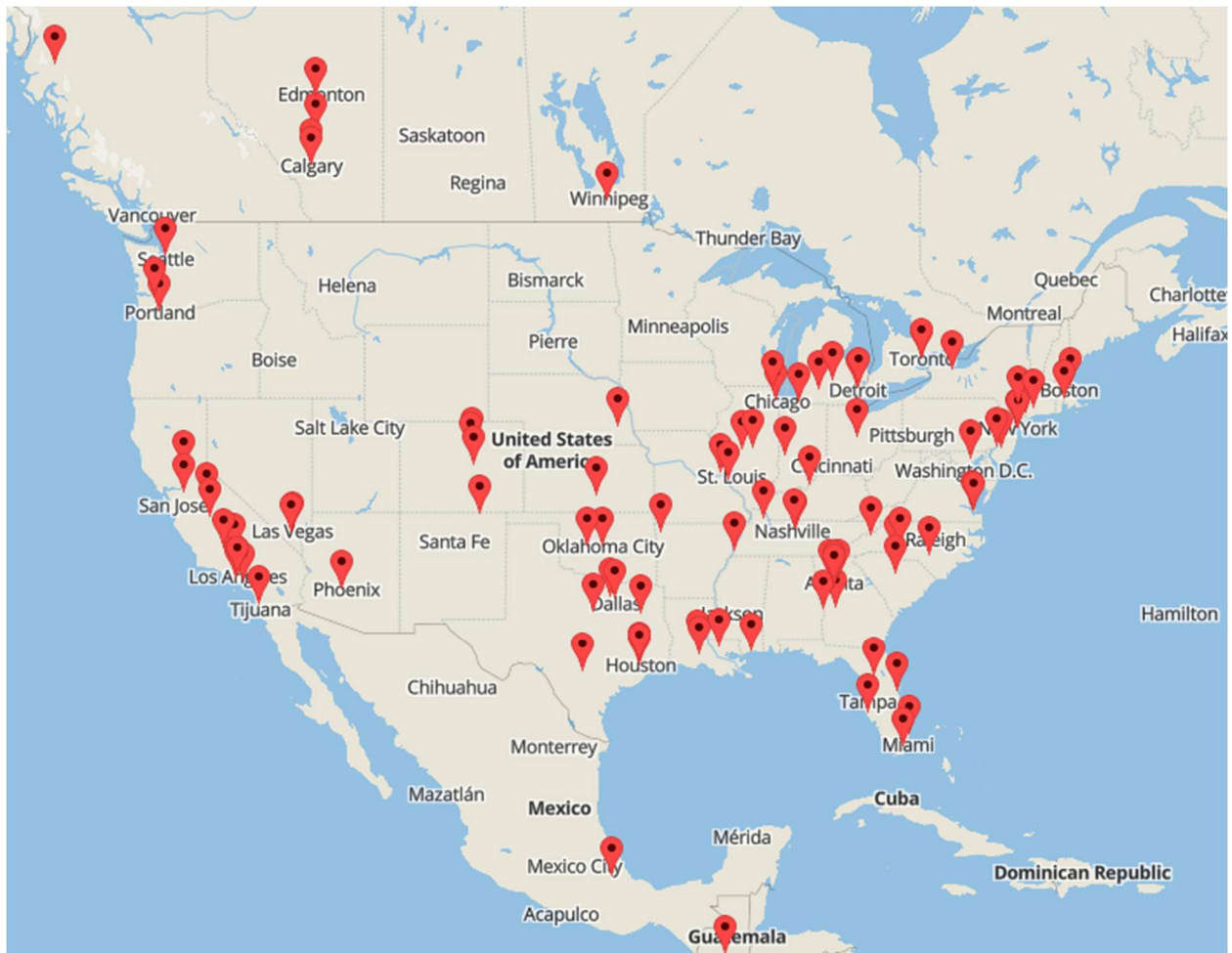

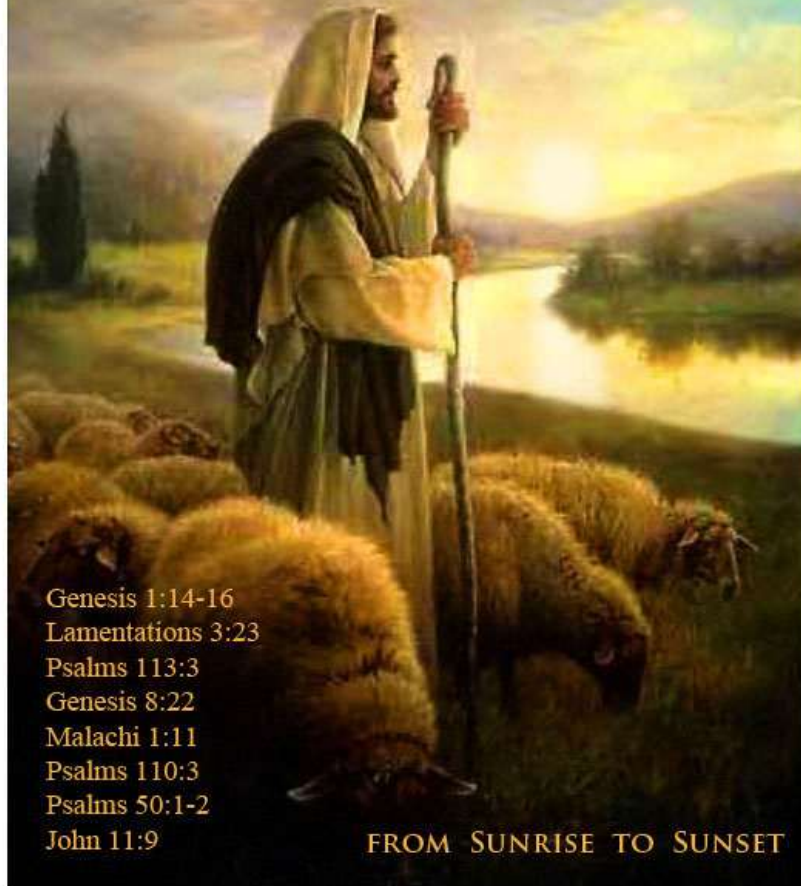
This is from the exact moment in time, but an enlargement of the USA, so you can see the details.

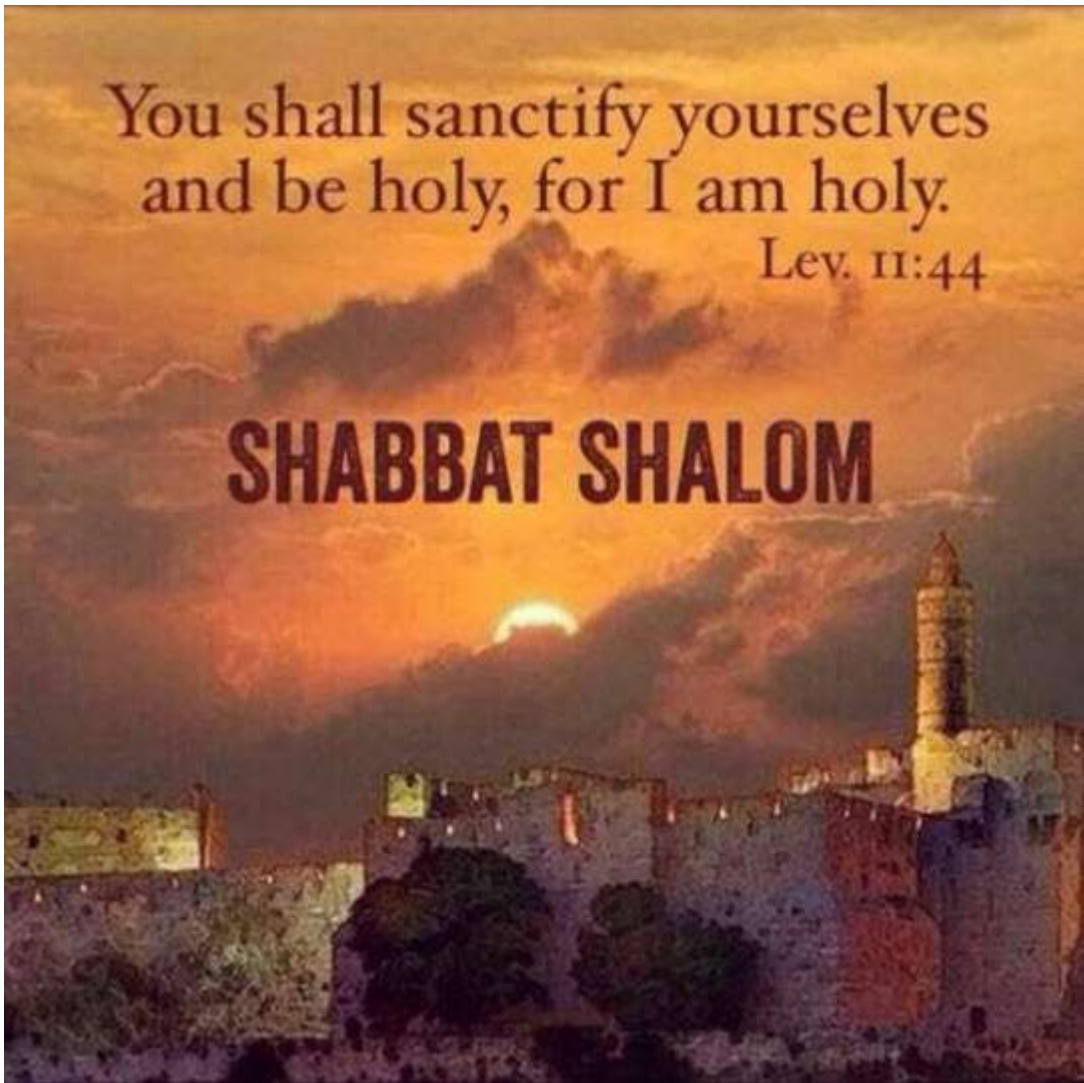

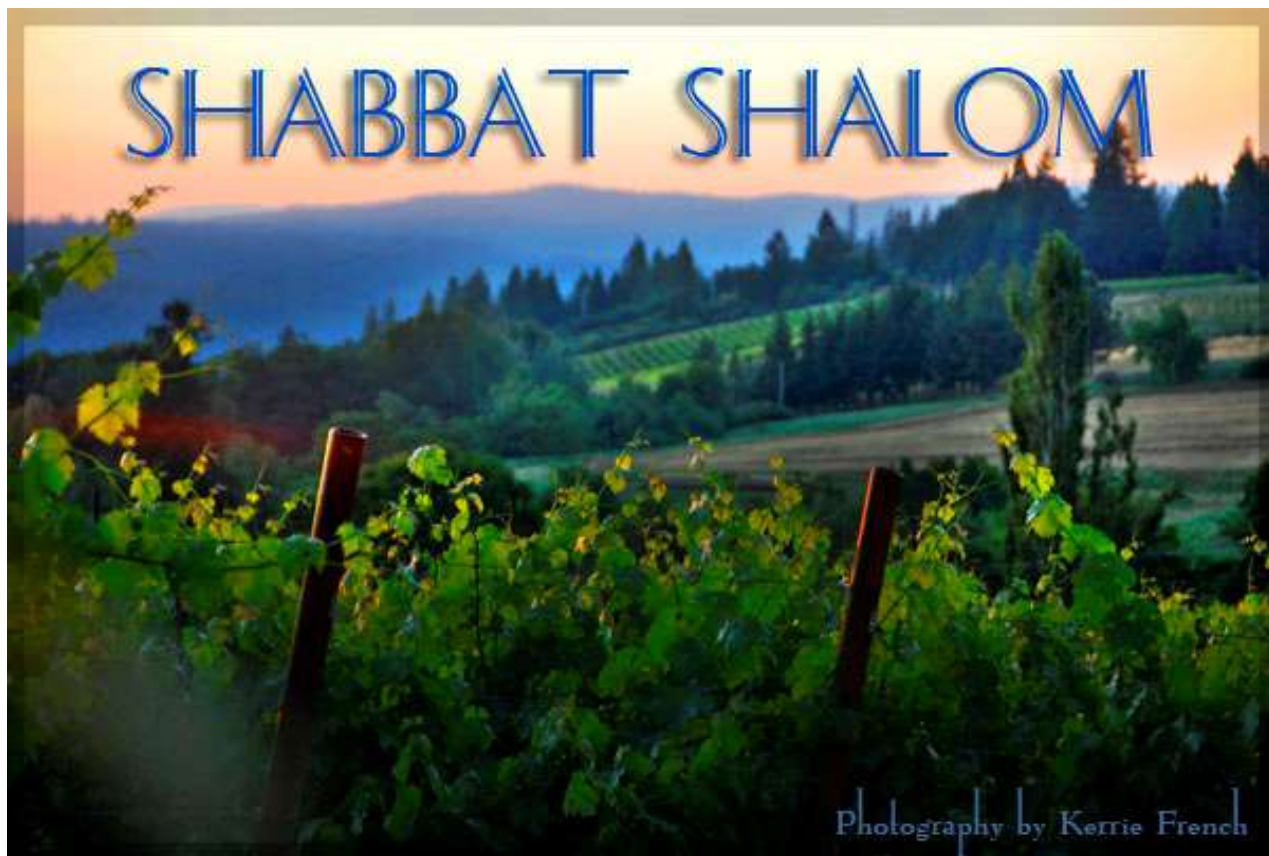
