

True Birthday of the Messiah

This illustration is based upon the narrative of Luke 1-2, and the 24 Kohen courses of service in the temple (1 Chronicles 24:7-18). These courses were repeated twice each astro-luni-solar year. The wheel of time below is separated into twelve lunar months. These are then divided by four lunar phases, Yahuah's pre-ordained time-measuring instrument of the unborn "from one New Moon to another." Isaiah 66:23

Of striking significance, the time continuum for both births, the prophet and our Messiah, are uniquely intertwined by divine design and commence at #1, where it states START HERE. The gold arrows point to prophet events, and the red arrows point to Messiah events.



Birth of Yahuchanon (John the Baptist) on New Moon Day of the 12th lunar month, three months after Angel Gabriel appeared to Mary. Luke 1:57-80

Mary returned home after three lunar months. She was now in her third month. Spring Luke 1:56

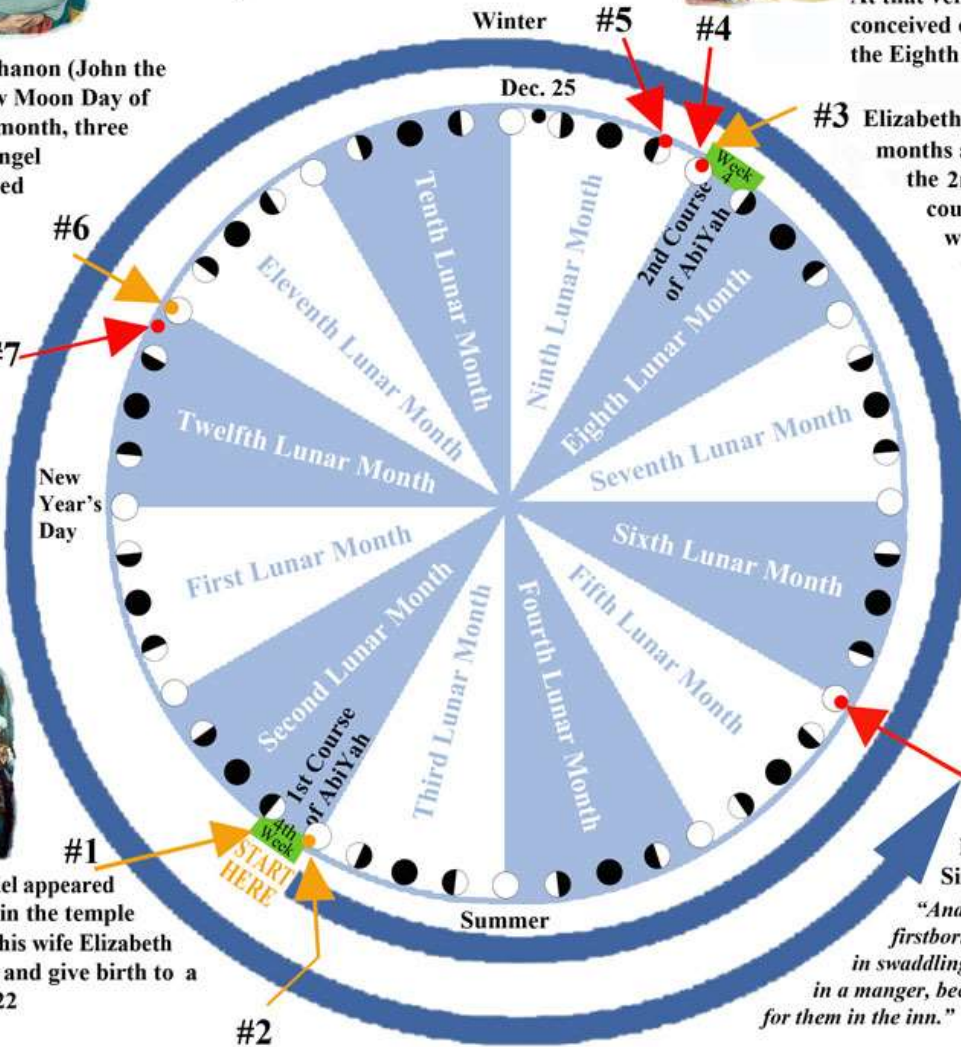


#1 The angel Gabriel appeared to ZachariYah in the temple and announced his wife Elizabeth was to conceive and give birth to a son. Luke 1:5-22

Mary arose, traveling from Nazareth to Judah, a journey of 4-5 days. Elizabeth's babe leaped in her womb at the sound of Mary's voice. It was a sign that Mary, at that early date carried the unborn Messiah. She stayed 3 lunar months. Luke 1: 39-55



The Angel Gabriel appeared to Mary, announcing she would conceive and bring forth a SON and call His name YAHUSHA. She accepted and said, "Let it be according to your word." Luke 1:26-38 At that very moment Mary conceived on the 30th day of the Eighth Lunar Month.



#2 Elizabeth conceives on the 30th day of the 2nd Lunar Month, the day after Sabbath and before the New Moon of the 3rd Month. Luke 1:23-24

He came that we might have life more abundantly. According to the promise, this babe became our LAMB, PRIEST, AND ETERNAL KING. HALLELUYAH!



#8 Birth of YAHUSHA the Messiah, on the New Moon day of the Sixth Lunar Month. "And she brought forth her firstborn son, and wrapped Him in swaddling clothes, and laid Him in a manger, because there was no room for them in the inn." Luke 2:1-8
