What Would You Ask For?

2 Chronicles 1:1-12 (emphasis on 6-12)

6) Solomon went up to the bronze altar before Yahuah Alahim in the Tent of Meeting and offered a thousand burnt offerings on it. 7) That night Alahim (God) appeared to Solomon and said to him, "Ask for whatever you want me to give you." 8) Solomon answered Alahim, "you have shown great kindness to David my father and have made me king in his place. 9) Now, Yahuah Alahim, let your promise to my father David be confirmed, for you have made me king over a people who are as numerous as the dust of the earth. 10) Give me wisdom and knowledge, that I may lead this people, for who is able to govern this great people of Yours?" 11) Alahim said to

Solomon, "Since this is your heart's desire and you have not asked for wealth, riches or honor, nor for the death of your enemies, and since you have not asked for a long life but for wisdom and knowledge to govern My people over whom I have made you king, 12) therefore wisdom and knowledge will be given you. And I will also give you wealth, riches and honor, such as no king who was before you ever had and none after you will have."

If Yahuah Alahim were to come to you and say, "*Ask for whatever you want me to give you,*" what would you ask for? Perhaps a happier life, a better marriage, a bigger house, a more successful career, more time for recreation, more wealth and riches, a larger ministry. These are not all bad things, but do they line up with what Alahim (God) would have for your life?

Let's make some observations from Solomon's request.

- 1. Solomon sought out Yahuah Alahim. (verse 6)
- 2. Alahim tested Solomon for the true desire of his heart. (verse 7)
- 3. Solomon recognized and acknowledged Alahim's sovereignty. (verse 8)
- 4. Solomon recognized and acknowledged the work Alahim gave him, and his *inability* to carry out this work on his own. (verse 9)
- 5. Solomon asked Alahim for the tools necessary to carry out his God-given work. (verse 10)
- 6. Alahim granted Solomon's request for wisdom and knowledge because that request lined up with Alahim's plan and His will. (verse 11 & 12)

What can we expect today in our encounters with Yahuah Alahim (God)?

- 1. Like Solomon, we are commanded to "seek Yahuah Alahim." (Jeremiah 29:12-13; Matthew 6:33 NKJV)
- 2. Yahuah Alahim will test us to reveal the true desires of our heart. (Psalm 17:3 NKJV)
- 3. We are expected to recognize and acknowledge Alahim's sovereignty. (Jeremiah 9:24; Psalm 100:3; Psalm 99:1-3; Psalm 97:1-6 NKJV)
- 4. We are expected to recognize and acknowledge the work Alahim has given us and our *inability* to carry it out through our own efforts. (2 Timothy 3:14-17; Colossians 1:24-29 NKJV)
- 5. We are expected to ask Yahuah Alahim for the tools necessary to carry out our God-given work. (John 14:12-14; NKJV)

6. We can expect when our request lines up with Alahim's plan and His will, He will grant us that request. (1John 5:14-15 NKJV)

I challenge you today, ask for wisdom and knowledge. Seek to know Yahuah Alahim and His will and make it the consistent pure motive of your heart. Exercise yourself toward godliness, and He will equip you more and more to do His kingdom work.

Prayer: Father, thank you for the example that You gave us of King Solomon. We ask for Your wisdom and knowledge to carry out the work You have for us. Help us to seek first Your kingdom and Your righteousness and all these other things will be added unto us. In the name of Your precious Son, Yahusha haMashiach (the Messiah).
