# THE SHANNAH

## *The Book of Mysteries*

“What is a year?” asked the teacher.

“Three hundred sixty-five days,” I answered.

“But in the holy language of Scripture, it’s more than that. It’s called *Shannah*...and it contains a secret. The word *Shannah* is linked to the number two.”

“I don’t get the connection.”

“*Shannah* can mean the second, the duplicate, or the repeat. In the course of nature, the year is the repeating of what has already been...the winter, the spring, the summer, and the fall, the blossoming of flowers and their withering away, the rebirth of nature and its dying, the same progression, the same replaying of what already was. So a year is a *Shannah*, a repetition. And now you have a new year before you. And what kind of year will it be?”

“What do you mean?”

“The nature of nature is to repeat, just as we live, by nature, as creatures of habit. We gravitate toward doing that which we’ve done before, the same routines and courses, even when those routines and courses are harmful to us. So what will the *Shannah*, this New Year (Rosh HaShannah), be for you?”

“Well, if the year means the repeat, I guess I don’t have much of a choice. It will be mostly the same as the one before.”

“But you do have a choice,” he said. “You see, *Shannah* has a double meaning. It not only means the **repeat**...it also means the **change**.”

“How can the same word mean the opposite?”

“The same way the year ahead of you can be either. The way of the world is to repeat, but the way of Yahuah Alahim is the way of renewing and change. You can’t know Him and not be changed by knowing Him. And His will is that the year, the *Shannah* (HaShannah), the one before you, be not a time of repetition, but of change. A year of new beginnings, new steps, of breaking out of the old. And if you want to experience a year of new things, you must choose to live not in the repetition of the infidel (the natural) but in the newness of the supernatural. Choose to walk not in your will but in the will of Him who is beyond the natural and beyond all that is of your old nature. As it is written, He makes all things new.” Open up your life to the newness of His will, “the renewing of your mind,” and you will walk in the newness of life and in the *Shannah* of change.”

**The Mission:** Today, step out of your old ways, habits, and paths. Do what you've never done before but should have. Walk in the newness of the *Shannah*, fully led by the Ruach haKadosh (Yah's power, presence and provision).

## Comments by Kerrie French

I love the presentation above. While the "teacher" in Jonathan Cahn's book explains many truths about the *Shannah* (year) in the above narrative, I'd like to add some additional clarification.

**I've discovered that in order to walk in the appointed path of our Creator and His Son our Messiah, and experience the renewal that is promised, we must synchronize our counting of days to those of our Creator. We must learn how to number our days in order to accurately meet the requirements of true worship (*Psalms 90:12*).** Shockingly, the only possible way to accurately follow the LAMB whether soever He goes (the part we play in obedience) is in understanding the dual principle born out in the Sanctuary/Temple model. From Moses through the time of our Messiah, the narrative was twofold. Salvation's story, performed by the Messiah alone, is founded upon the principles of specific TIME and EVENT.

Then in following, we discover that there is a right and wrong way to count the days of the year and a right and wrong place to start and end the year. This can include the modern solar calendar created by the Romans, the calendar of the Rabbinical Jews that commences with the dark conjunction lunar phase, or the crescent of the Karaite Jews, Islam, and witchcraft. If we start our New Year, Months, Sabbaths, or Feast Days according to any other method than what has been laid before us in Scripture, then we are worshiping alone. Meaning, the Most High, Yahuah Alahim, the object of our worship is not present with us to receive our worship. But still more importantly, we will miss the significance of the time-centric appointed days that declare the WAY OF SALVATION performed by our Messiah for you and me. (Yes it is true that in our ignorance He will honor our efforts, but when the truth has been shown us or we choose to ignore it, He will no longer turn a blind eye.)

There is no provision in the pages of Scripture from Genesis to Revelation for worshiping according to solar years that commence in winter, months of varying days from 28-31, continuous weekly cycles, or days removed from their demarcation of 29-30 lunar phases. Neither is there mention for honoring the dark or crescent lunar phases.

Scripture is consistent, and Yahuah and His Son repeatedly illustrate their method of time-keeping is central to the plan of salvation. It is the correct method of it that identifies the authentic Messiah, who died for our sins on Passover (not Easter) of the lunar month of Abib (Aviv) on the day of a solar eclipse, clarifying that 14 days earlier the New Moon was FULL. Together, the combined elements of authentic truths are now calling you and me out of Babylon, the scrambled truth with error, and the fictional methods of timekeeping, born out of rebellion to the sacred Torah Law and instructions of the Most High, Yahuah Alahim and His Son, Yahusha haMashiach.

All in all it testifies of the persistent presence of the great love and compassion of our Creator and Redeemer. But on the flip side, we are also given a glimpse into the continued destructive rebellious work of Satan since creation to undermine and separate the people of earth from their Maker. But we always have a choice. And that choice of who we serve will always include a calendar identifying when we serve, a way of counting days. Will it be according to a man-made system designed to be in rebellion to the Creator, or will it be the one and only time-measuring model preordained by the Most High to guide you and me ever closer to the heart of our Maker and Redeemer. "Choose you this day whom you will serve!"

If you are not already on this path of the Most High, you are invited today, to prepare for the renewal of your heart, mind, and soul that begins with Rosh Hashannah (New Year's Day) on 04-27-2021.
