THE NAME IN WHICH YOU ARE

We were sitting in the sandy plain, in the same place where the teacher had in the past drawn symbols in the sand. But this time he handed me the stick and asked me to draw. So I did, slowly, as he directed. When I was finished, he told me what it was that I inscribed in the sand.

"Each of the symbols you drew," he said, "is a Hebrew letter. The first is the *yod*. The second is the *shin*. The third is the *vav*. And the last is the *ayin*. Do you recognize it?" he asked. "It's how the name *Yeshua* looks in Hebrew, which was then translated into 'Jesus."

"Yeshua," I replied, "Messiah's real name."

"Yes," said the teacher, "but think about it. He wasn't always Yeshua or Jesus."

"What do you mean?"

"Before the creation, the Son was with the Father and the Word was with God. He was the Son. And He was the Word. But He wasn't called Yeshua. In view of eternity, He has only borne the name Yeshua for a very short time. Why was it that He was given that name?

"Because He was to save His people from their sins."

"Do you remember what Yeshua actually means?"

"God is salvation."

"Yes. So it wasn't His inherent name nor His Name from the beginning. In the beginning, there was no sin, no darkness, no fall, no crisis, no brokenness, no judgment, no death, no need for salvation. For His Name to be Yeshua from the beginning would make no sense. Think about it. His Name is Yeshua because of us...because of our need to be saved. So every time His name is spoken, it proclaims His being joined to us. And He chose to bear that name forever. And do you know what else that name means? It means we're actually in His Name. It's the salvation of us that His Name is declaring. It's the salvation of you. His Name declares your salvation. You're in His Name. And when you receive Yeshua, when He becomes your salvation ... then it's all complete."

"It's as if His Name is a prophecy...a prophecy that comes true when you receive it."

"His Name is a mystery in which we are part. And when you receive the name, then the name is fulfilled. The Son of the Most High Alahim (God) becomes your salvation. And all who receive the name... are already in it...Yeshua."

**The Mission:** Ponder this mystery: You are in His Name. He was named for you. You are joined forever. Seek what that means. And live this day in that joining. *Isaiah 12:1-3; Jeremiah 23:5-7; Jeremiah 33:16; Matthew 1:21; John 1:1-2.*

## **Comments by Kerrie French**

I love the marvelous message in this devotional by Jonathan Cahn, where His teacher identifies that our Messiah's very name carries the prophecy of our Salvation. And thereby, in calling upon His authentic Hebrew name we are receiving His salvation. By extension, there can be no salvation by any other name, such as the name *Jesus*. Yet, in the Father's compassion and mercy toward us, I have no doubt that He has honored our ignorance when we prayed in the name of Jesus. But His desire is to restore His truths to all those who declare to be His followers. Ultimately, these will hear and accept this truth of His sacred and prophetic name. All His truths are now being restored as a vetting system for entrance into His Kingdom government. In this way, He will know who His true followers are who seek to be faithful and obedient and who long for an eternal home with Him and put away the long-held traditions of men that carry no sacred application.

Because we are focusing on this most sacred name, the name above all names, it is so important to get it right. Not to be petty, but to seek correctness. Thus, I have to disagree with the spelling and the pronunciation of the Messiah's Hebrew name provided by Jonathan Cahn and His teacher, which is the traditional name used in modern Israel for the Messiah. Historically, the Jews have side-stepped the correct pronunciation of the sacred names, and the Messiah's name is no different in my estimation.

His Hebrew name is most often spelled yod ('), hey (ה), vav (1), shin (ש), ayin (ע), then placed from right to left as recorded throughout the Scriptural text and pronounced Ya-hoo-sha (H#3091 - Yahusha). It is this name and with this spelling that is consistently recorded in the Tanakh (Old Testament) Scripture 218 times. Note the last two are also spelled this same way in Hebrew, but recorded in English differently.

Although, in the Hebrew Scriptures our Messiah's name is consistently spelled (##3091 - Yahusha), in the Strong's Hebrew Dictionary it is also spelled: (Yahushua). The addition of the second vav (לו) causes the name to have the "shua" at the end. This appears to originate in the Hebrew Masoretic tradition in which vowel points were added to bring continuity

to their choice of pronunciation. Yet, when the vowel points are removed, restoring to Hebrew to it usage at the time of our Messiah, we are returned to the pronunciation of Yahusha.

The other forms of this most sacred name came to be as a result of the invention of *vowel points*, as recent as the 12<sup>th</sup> century A.D., and is predominantly utilized in the Masoretic Text.

The Hebrew Name Yahusha was later replaced by the Greco/Roman name *Hesus*, which later became the Latin *Isous*, later *Iesus*, and much later still in the 17th century A.D. when the "J" was added to the English language, it was changed again, becoming *Jesus*. Ironically, there has never been a "J" letter or sound in the Hebrew language. So the use of the "J" in our Messiah's name is the surest sign of wrong spelling and pronunciation, such as in *Jehovah* or *Jesus*.

The Greco/Roman spelling of the Messiah's name changing multiple times over the last 2,000 years is great evidence that the name so popularly utilized among Christians of every denomination, is entirely fictional, and groundless. Yet, those claiming to be Bible believers and specifically "Christians," will never change what they call the Messiah as long as they are tied to a Christian church. Why? Because Christianity is founded upon the principles of Roman Catholicism, by whom the name *Jesus* has so purposely and carefully replaced the authentic Messiah's name. And while all Protestant churches have protested Catholicism on some level, they still carry her DNA in many ways not generally recognized by them. Some Protestant churches were formed after the "J" was applied to *Iesus*, making it *Jesus*. And some of these having an acclaimed prophet who utilized the name *Jesus*, would be at odds with their modern prophet if they chose to implement His authentic Hebrew name in its place, or be forced to recognize their presumed prophet to be a fraud.

Below is the literal text copied from the 1611 King James version of Scripture in my eSword 1611 KJV Bible. Note the spelling of the Messiah's name is *Iesus*. So it is that the new name with its spelling with a "J" came to exist since this Bible version was first printed.

Mat 1:1 The booke of the generation of *Iesus* Christ, the sonne of Dauid, the sonne of Abraham.

And while Lew White's video presentation is accurate in pronunciation, I believe the last letter of our Messiah's name was originally the *hey* ( $\overline{\mathbf{n}}$ ) as it also carries the same *ah* sound as with the *ayin* ( $\mathbf{V}$ ). My reasoning for this is simple. The (H#7716 -  $\overline{\mathbf{v}}$  $\overline{\mathbf{n}}$ ) literally spells LAMB in Hebrew. It is the formula from the beginning in Eden when the first lamb ( $\overline{\mathbf{v}}$  $\overline{\mathbf{n}}$ -sha) was slain, and the Creator placed the white blood-stained woolen skins upon our first parents. For this was the SIGN of the promise of our Messiah unto SALVATION. For it is His eternal robes of righteousness that cover His obedient followers. (Genesis 3:21).

Each of us has been provided the choice to be grafted in and receive both the FATHER AND SON'S KADOSH NAME on our foreheads, by accepting and receiving His Son. Pray that this name will be YAHUSHA TWITT. For both, the Father and Son's power, presence, and provision are only baked into the correct NAME of YAHUSHA HAMASHIACH, unto salvation. This Kadosh NAME is declaring to the whole world that the ETERNAL YAHUAH THE LAMB YOU AND ME BY WAY OF HIS ONLY BEGOTTEN SON, YAHUSHA THE LAMB (H#7716-TW-sha). In this way, both the Father and Son's names begin and end with the same letters. The only letter different is the shin (U). It is through this method alone that YAHUSHA OUR MESSIAH ensures that His FATHER'S promises are trustworthy UNTO ETERNAL LIFE.
