THE SEED By Jonathan Cahn

Kerrie's Comments on New Moon Day (Chodesh H#2320):

Chodesh (H#2320) is the Hebrew term for New Moon. As you can see below it is rarely published in the Bible as the New Moon. This results is folks not taking it seriously. Seems like a proactive attack and hidden agenda to me. Often folks will contact me and say what's the big deal, the New Moon is only in the Bible twelve times as listed here. While each of these are accurate, so are the other nearly **300** as listed below them, but translated into mere "months, moons, or monthly." The problem here is that when folks read in their Bibles the term "months" they automatically assume it refers to Roman Solar Months. And because we were born with the innate desire to fit in, we never tend to question this.

But here at the end of time YAHUAH Alahim and YAHUSHA haMashiach are giving the clarion call to come out of the false teachings begun first in Babylon, utilized in Egypt, shared with Julius Caesar of the Roman Empire, and further altered by Emperor Constantine, and later Pope Gregory. With all of these changes, what a privilege it is to be one who has heard the call to COME OUT OF BABYLON!!! Let us continue to pray for those who have not yet heard or responded.

<u>Psa_81:3</u> Blow the trumpet at the time of the <u>New Moon</u>, At the full moon, on our solemn feast day.

<u>Isa_66:23</u> And it shall come to pass *That* from one <u>New Moon</u> to another, And from one Sabbath to another, All flesh shall come to worship before Me," says YAHUAH.

<u>Eze_46:1</u> 'Thus says YAHUAH Alahim: "The gateway of the inner court that faces toward the east shall be shut the six working days; but on the Sabbath it shall be opened, and on the day of the New Moon it shall be opened.

<u>Eze_46:6</u> On the day of the <u>New Moon</u> *it shall be* a young bull without blemish, six lambs, and a ram; they shall be without blemish.





HOLIDAYS (yamim tobim, singular yom tob, corrupted in popular speech to Yontovim and Yontev). The Jewish holidays may be grouped under the following heads:

1. Sabbath and New Moon (Rosh Hodesh), both periodically recurring in the course of the year. The New Moon is still, and the Sabbath originally was, dependent upon the lunar cycle. Both date back to the nomadic period of Israel. Originally the New Moon was celebrated in the same way as the Sabbath; gradually it became less important, while the Sabbath became more and more a day of religion and humanity, of religious meditation and instruction, of peace and delight of the soul, and produced powerful and beneficent effects outside of Judaism.
