Today is the **22nd day** of our Creator's **Twelfth Lunar Month** count, in which the year begins in the spring. It is also the authentic **third lunar Sabbath of the month**. It looks like **12-22-5993**. It coincides with the Roman Gregorian calendar planetary date of *Fri.*, 04-04-2025.

Our Creator placed His full moon beacon as the original New Moon and the start of His months, high above for all to see. All praise to Yahuah Alahim for His steadfast love and compassion for His children and His patience in restoring His lost truths in preparation for the Second Coming of His Son, Yahusha haMashiach (the Messiah). Simply because the full moon as New Moon, with its count to Lunar Sabbaths and annual Feast Days, is not popular among the Rabbinical Pharisee Jews or the Romanized Christian churches today, does in no way diminish its LIGHT OF

TRUTH shining from the pages of Scripture and His Eternal Throne. Only Yahuah's Ruach (power, presence, and provision) gives those who seek Him with all their hearts *"eyes to see and ears to hear."* Ask Him today to reveal His New Moon and lunar Sabbath to you and see how your life will change as your soul temple is synchronized to His for all eternity.

Infinity in a Jar By Jonathan Cahn

It was morning. The teacher came to my room holding a little clay jar. A question, he said. "Can that which is little contain that which is big?"

"No," I answered.

"Can that which is finite encompass that which is infinite?"

"No," I said again.

"But it can," he replied.

"How?"

He lifted the jar and removed the cap from its top.

"It can," he said. "It can if it's an open vessel. A closed vessel can never contain anything larger than its own size. But an open vessel has no limitations. It now can contain the blowing of the wind or the outpouring of the rain. It could even contain the flowing of a river."

"It would take a long time to contain a river."

"It could take forever, but the principle is the same."

"And the reason you're showing me this..."

"Which is larger, that which you know or that which you don't know?"

"That which I don't know, I would think."

"So then, it's only wise that you seek that which you don't know."

"I guess."

"But how do you contain that which is bigger than you... that which is bigger than your ability to comprehend?"

"By becoming an open vessel," I said.

"Yes," said the teacher. "Only by opening yourself up can you come to know that which you don't already know. And only by becoming an open vessel can you contain that which is greater than yourself. The truth is always greater than our knowing. Your mind and heart are finite, clay jars. **But the truth has no end.** Yahuah Alahim (God) has no end. The Eternal is infinite...always flowing."

"Like a river," I said.

"Yes," he said, "but when the jar opens itself, it becomes unlimited. It can contain the waters of the river... So open now your mind, your heart, and your life. For it is only the open vessel and an open heart that can contain the infinity of Yahuah Alahim."

Kerrie's Korner:

The New Year is nearly upon us, nine days away. While Passover will be the focus for the next few weeks, it all must start at the very beginning with Rosh Hashanah (New Year's Day).

Genesis 1:1 speaks of that day "IN THE BEGINNING" (Rosh), and 2,500 years later Exodus 12:2 repeats "THE BEGINNING OF LUNAR MONTHS AND YEARS (Rosh Hashanah). These two witnesses create a sturdy foundation of truth.

Rosh Hashanah Yahuah's *New Year's Day in Spring*



Rosh Hashanah has been for nearly 1,700 years traditionally celebrated by the Yahudim (Jews) as New Year's Day in autumn, placing it on the same day as Yom Teruah, the Feast of Trumpets. Yet, no matter how long this erroneous tradition has been honored, it is time to restore Rosh Hashanah to YAHUAH'S true and original New Year's Day in SPRING, as defined by YAHUAH Alahim to Moses

and Aaron 14 days prior to the first PASSOVER, as recorded in Exodus 12. For this is His appointed beginning of lunar months signaled by the full New Moon near the feet of the constellation of Bethulah (Virgo) as the Rosh (first) constellation of the year, and sets the count to PASSOVER (Pasch), the 14th day.

Without first locating this predominant day of the sacred year correctly, all the full moons that rise in the east for the start of lunar months, lunar seventh-day Sabbaths, and Kadosh (sacred) lunar appointed Feast days will be hopelessly out of sync with the imperial worship rhythm of our Creator, Yahuah Alahim.
