Today is the **29th day** of our Creator's **Twelfth Lunar Month** count, in which the year begins in the spring. It is also the authentic **fourth lunar Sabbath of the month**. It looks like **12-29-5993.** It coincides with the Roman Gregorian calendar planetary date of *Fri.*, 04-11-2025.

Rosh Hashanah (New Year's Day in spring, 01-01-5994) will occur on the pagan *Sun.*, 04-13-2025.

Our Creator placed His full moon beacon as the original New Moon and the start of His months, high above for all to see. All praise to Yahuah Alahim for His steadfast love and compassion for His children and His patience in restoring His lost truths in preparation for the Second Coming of His Son, Yahusha haMashiach (the Messiah).

Simply because the full moon as New Moon, with its count to Lunar Sabbaths and annual Feast Days, is not popular among the Rabbinical Pharisee Jews or the Romanized Christian churches today, does in no way diminish its LIGHT OF TRUTH shining from the pages of Scripture and His Eternal Throne. Only Yahuah's Ruach (power, presence, and provision) gives those who seek Him with all their hearts *"eyes to see and ears to hear."* Ask Him today to reveal His New Moon and lunar Sabbath to you and see how your life will change as your soul temple is synchronized to His for all eternity.

"The word was created by babies," he said. "All across the world, in almost every language on earth, you can hear in the word for mother, the cry of a baby: *mamma, mom, amma, ema, mai, mata, and ma*. It comes from those first longings, the longing for milk. And all these words bear witness that to our longings there existed an answer."

"But this is not about babies"

"No. Our longing for milk passes away, but we find another longing within our hearts ...another emptiness ...another hunger ...but deeper ...a longing for that which the world never answers. We long for the perfect, for a perfect love, a perfect happiness, a perfect contentment, and a perfect peace. We long for that which doesn't fail, that which never disappoints us, or grows old, or passes away. We long for the eternal and the perfect. But the world can never answer those longings ... and still they stay with us all the days of our lives. We long for it though we've never tasted it. And our very longings bear witness that what we had never seen or tasted was real."

"We long for the perfect because the perfect exists ... as we once longed for milk?"

"Yes, and we long for a perfect love because there is a Perfect Love. We long for the Eternal because the Eternal exists and the Eternal put that longing into our hearts so we would seek Him ...and find Him."

"So in the same way that our longing for milk once bore witness that although we had never yet seen it, milk existed, now the longing that is now in our hearts for the perfect, for the Eternal, for heaven bears witness that, although we have not yet seen it, heaven exists. Heaven is real and the promise is sure."

"Yes," he said, "our deepest longing are the witness of the milk of heaven."

Like the infant for milk unseen, I cry out for a love unfailing, for joy that cannot fade, for peace not stolen by the night.



Barak hashem Yahusha haMashiach! (Bless the name of Yahusha the Messiah!)

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
