Today is the **29th day** of our Creator's **Twelfth Lunar Month** count, in which the year begins in the spring. It is also the authentic **fourth lunar Sabbath of the month**. It looks like **12-29-5994**. It coincides with the Roman Gregorian calendar planetary date of *Tues, 03-31-2026*.

Our Creator placed His full moon beacon as the original New Moon and the start of His months, high above for all to see. All praise to Yahuah Alahim for His steadfast love and compassion for His children and His patience in restoring His lost truths in preparation for the Second Coming of His Son, Yahusha haMashiach (the Messiah). Simply because the full moon as New Moon, with its count to Lunar Sabbaths and annual Feast Days, is not popular among the Rabbinical Pharisee Jews or the Romanized Christian churches today, does in no way diminish its LIGHT OF TRUTH shining from the pages of Scripture and His Eternal Throne. Only Yahuah's Ruach (power, presence, and provision) gives those who seek Him with all their hearts "*eyes to see and ears to hear.*" Ask Him today to reveal His New Moon and

# **Rosh Hashanah**

## ***Yahuah's New Year's Day in Spring***

Rosh Hashanah has been celebrated by the Yahudim (Jews) for nearly 1,700 years as New Year's Day in autumn, coinciding with Yom Teruah, the Feast of Trumpets. Yet, no matter how long this erroneous tradition has been honored, it is time to restore Rosh Hashanah to YHUH (Yahuah) Alahim's true and original New Year's Day in SPRING. Rosh Hashanah is first represented by the words "IN THE BEGINNING" in Genesis 1:1 and later defined by Yahuah to Moses and Aaron by night, fourteen days prior to the first PASSOVER, as recorded in Exodus 12:3.

With the addition of Genesis 1:16, we discover that the lesser light (the moon) was ordained to rule together with the stars by night, identifying the full moon as the original start of lunar months, as it alone rules by night with the stars from east to west all night long. So, together with the stars, the first full moon in the spring announces ROSH HASHANAH. The Creator's appointed beginning of lunar months can only be signaled by the full New/Renewed Moon near the feet of the constellation of Bethulah (Virgo), which rises in the east by night in the spring alone, as the Rosh (first) constellation of the year, and sets the count to PASSOVER (Pasch) and all the full New Moon Days, lunar Sabbaths, and lunar appointed Feast Days.

Without first locating the correct starry constellation that rises in the east in spring and the original ordained full New/Renewed New Moon to rule together by night to announce the Kodesh (sacred) year, all lunar Sabbaths, and lunar appointed Feast days will be hopelessly out of sync with the imperial worship rhythm of our Creator, Yahuah Alahim. **Kerrie's Korner:** While this is the last Sabbath of the month, it is not the last day. The last day of the month is the following day, the 30<sup>th</sup> day of this last lunar month. That evening, we will witness the first full moon rise in the east, announcing the following morning at sunrise to be Rosh Hashanah, otherwise known as Biblical New Year's Day in the spring.

Today's study is the first of two. We will explore the second study on Rosh Hashanah itself. Review the calendar above to know when that is.
