

The preamble to this Hebrew Word Study is established by King David and found in Psalms 104:19.

**“He ordained (H#6213 *asah*) the MOON (H#3394 *Yareach*) for SEASONS (H#4150 – *mo’ed* - [lunar] appointed times)...”**

*Psalms 104:19*

What this means is that Yahuah Alahim appointed **lunar time** for **all appointed times of assembly (H#4150 – *mo’ed*)**. So when you read in Genesis 1:14 the word “seasons” or in Leviticus 23 the word “feasts” it really means **(H#4150 – *mo’ed* [lunar] appointed times)**. But stunningly, that is not all! As illustrated below the original and authentic seventh-day Sabbath is also established as a **(H#4150 – *mo’ed* [lunar] appointed time)**, meaning it occurs upon the lunar calendar cycle alone.

**“He ordained the MOON for SEASONS (#4150 – mo’edim - the lunar appointed fixed times of assembly); the brilliant rays of the SUN reveals and endues it, making known its entrance [in the east].” Tehilim (Psalms) 104:19 (This explains what governs the time element of “SEASONS” in Genesis 1:14.)**

**“It shall be established FOREVER like the MOON, even like the trustworthy WITNESS in the sky.” Tehilim (Psalms) 89:37**

**Annual Feast Days** – Each of the **yearly lunar appointed times (often called lunar Feast Days)** follow in their sequential order according to the lunar principles provided here. It is because the seventh-day Sabbaths are also identified as **lunar appointed times** that each of the **yearly Feast Days** are dually tied to both their approximation to the seventh-day Sabbath as well as to the count from the New Moon. This is a fact that renders weeks and Sabbaths that cycle perpetually without end a Scriptural impossibility.

**Overlapping** – Additionally, because both **seventh-day Sabbaths** and the yearly **prophetic rehearsal assembly events** are **lunar appointed times** (H#4150 mo’ed) and counted from the same lunar New Moon (H#2320 chodesh), it is impossible for these days to overlap each other. It is only when utilizing the Roman Gregorian solar wall calendar, or its equivalent, that the New Moons appear to float through weekdays and Saturdays alike. But when utilizing the Scriptural astro-luni-solar calendar alone, New Moons and Sabbaths NEVER overlap. Overlapping is a paradigm only enjoyed by the Roman solar adherents as they inadvertently mix two calendar models together, the Creator’s astro-luni-solar model and the Roman’s strictly solar system.

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
