Lunar Time for All Sacred Assemblies

The premise for this Hebrew Word Study is established by King David and found in Psalms 104:19.

"He ordained (H#6213 asah) the MOON (H#3394 Yareach) for SEASONS (H#4150 – mo'ed - lunar appointed times)..." Psalms 104:19

What this means is that Yahuah Alahim our Creator appointed <u>lunar time</u> <u>measuring</u> for all appointed times of assembly (H#4150 - mo'ed). So when you read in Genesis 1:14 the word "seasons" or in Leviticus 23 the word "feasts" it really means $(H\#4150 - mo'ed \ \underline{lunar \ appointed \ times})$. But stunningly, that is not all!

As illustrated below the original and authentic seventh-day Sabbath of creation as restored in Exodus 12:1-3 and explained in Leviticus is also established upon the very same principle, as a (H#4150 – mo'ed lunar appointed time). This means it occurs upon the lunar calendar cycle alone and not upon Saturday of the Roman planetary continuous weekly cycle, the popular yet earliest form of Social Media's Fake News. Are you aware that neither Saturday nor Sunday are recorded anywhere in Scripture. Add to this that neither is their continuous weekly cycle. Stunningly, all days of the lunar month including the seventh-day Sabbaths are counted from the New Moon Day each month.

"He ordained the MOON for SEASONS (#4150 – mo'edim - the lunar appointed times); the brilliant rays of the SUN reveals and endues it, making known its entrance [in the east]." Tehilim (Psalms) 104:19 (This explains what is meant by "SEASONS" and the time element that governs it. Genesis 1:14.)


Annual Feast Days – Each of the yearly <u>lunar appointed times</u> (H#4150 mo'ed) often called lunar Feast Days, follow in their sequential order according to the lunar principles provided here. It is because the seventh-day Sabbaths are also identified as <u>lunar appointed times</u> (H#4150 mo'ed) that each of the yearly Feast Days are dually tied to both their approximation to the seventh-day Sabbath as well as to the count from the New Moon. This is a fact that renders weeks and Sabbaths that cycle perpetually without end a Scriptural impossibility.

Overlapping – Additionally, because both seventh-day Sabbath <u>lunar</u> appointed times (H#4150 mo'ed) and the yearly prophetic rehearsal assembly events are also <u>lunar</u> appointed times (H#4150 mo'ed) and counted from the same lunar New Moon phase (H#2320 chodesh), it is impossible for these days to overlap each other. It is only when utilizing the Roman Gregorian solar wall calendar, or its equivalent, that the New Moons appear to float through weekdays and Saturdays alike.

But when utilizing the Scriptural astro-luni-solar calendar alone, New Moons and Sabbaths NEVER overlap. Overlapping is a paradigm only enjoyed by the Roman solar adherents such as the Jews who proactively combine two calendar models together (the solar and the lunar) through a process called the Rules of Postponement. Without this interface, like oil and water, the two calendar models can never be harmonized. Might the introduction and usage of the Roman solar calendar be the very reason why the New Moons, lunar Sabbaths, and the lunar Feast Days are no longer recognized as viable? Might this be the very cause that they cannot be kept without first discarding the solar calendar and restoring the Creator's original?

YET, Genesis 1:14-16 defines that the FULL MOON as New Moon, together with the STARS RULE ALL NIGHT WITHOUT the SUN. So the above reference to the New Moons, Sabbaths, and Feast Days that YAHUAH ELOHIM could not bear, were 180 degrees opposite of His ordained TIME STANDARD.
