

Yahusha HaMashiach Washes the Disciples' Feet

Joh 13:1 Now before the Feast of the Passover, when Yahusha knew that His hour had come that He should depart from this world to the Father, having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.

Joh 13:2 And supper being ended, the devil having already put it into the heart of Judas Iscariot, Simon's *son*, to betray Him,

Joh 13:3 Yahusha, knowing that the Father had given all things into His hands, and that He had come from Yahuah Alahim and was going to Yahuah Alahim,

Joh 13:4 rose from supper and laid aside His garments, took a towel and girded Himself.

Joh 13:5 After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash the disciples' feet, and to wipe *them* with the towel with which He was girded.

Joh 13:6 Then He came to Simon Peter. And *Peter* said to Him, "Master, are You washing my feet?"

Joh 13:7 Yahusha answered and said to him, "What I am doing you do not understand now, but you will know after this."

Joh 13:8 Peter said to Him, "You shall never wash my feet!" Yahusha answered him, "If I do not wash you, you have no part with Me."

Joh 13:9 Simon Peter said to Him, "Master, not my feet only, but also *my* hands and *my* head!"

Joh 13:10 Yahusha said to him, "He who is bathed needs only to wash *his* feet, but is completely clean; and you are clean, but not all of you."

Joh 13:11 For He knew who would betray Him; therefore He said, "You are not all clean."

Joh 13:12 So when He had washed their feet, taken His garments, and sat down again, He said to them, "Do you know what I have done to you?"

Joh 13:13 You call Me Teacher and Master, and you say well, for *so* I am.

Joh 13:14 If I then, *your* Master and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.

Joh 13:15 For I have given you an example, that you should do as I have done to you.

Joh 13:16 Most assuredly, I say to you, a servant is not greater than his master; nor is he who is sent greater than he who sent him.

Joh 13:17 If you know these things, blessed are you if you do them.
